



STAR BOX CHRISTMAS TREE

Level – Intermediate

Instructions

1. Cut your stars from the Under the Tree Specialty Designer Series Paper and cut 3 of the smallest star from the Glimmer Paper.
2. Cut strips in coordinating coloured cardstock for the box sides and score. Refer to the Table below for measurements



3. Concertina your strips and burnish score lines.

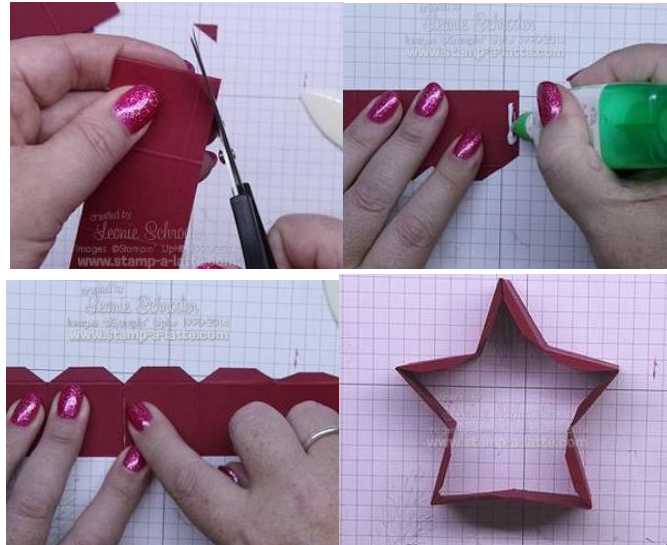

4. Snip corners off the 'seam' section and affix ends together and concertina into a star shape.



5. Draw a thin line of Tombow Multipurpose adhesive around the edge of one of your stars and affix one of your star sides to your star. Hold in place for 20-30 seconds for the bond to hold.



6. Take your other Star 'side' and place inside the star box you just made ensuring the flaps/seams are facing up and apply Tombow Adhesive to flaps/seams.



7. Layer remaining star on top and hold in place for 20-30 seconds for bond to hold.



8. Now you have a top and a bottom to your star box and they fit perfectly together!



9. Make one box of each size and stack them to make a 'tree'. Using your three stars cut from the Glimmer Paper adhere together at the side points with a mini glue dot and place on top of your 'tree'

Star Box Measurement Chart

Star Framelit	Strips to cut	Strip Size	Score
#1 (largest)	4	4cm x 21cm 1 ½" x 8 ¼"	1cm & every 4cm ¼" & every 1 ½"
#2	4	3.5cm x 19cm 1 ½" x 6 ½"	1cm & every 3.2cm ¼" & every 1 ¼"
#3	2	3cm x 23cm 1 ¼" x 9 ¼"	2.3cm & every 2.2cm 7/8" & every 7/8"
#4	2	2.5cm x 16cm 1" x 6 ½"	1cm & every 1.5cm 3/8" & every 5/8"
