



Dandy Garden Fun Fold Card

Level – Beginner/Casual

Time –15 minutes

Stamp

- Dragonfly Garden Stamp Set

Paper

- Bumble Bee A4 Cardstock
- Whisper White A4 Cardstock - 106549
- Dandy Garden DSP Stack

Ink

- Tuxedo Black Memento Ink Pad - 132708
- Misty Moonlight Classic Ink Pad
- Pumpkin Pie Stampin' Blends Combo
- Daffodil Delight Light Stampin' Blends Marker -
- Balmy Blue Light Stampin Blends
- Flirty Flamingo Light Stampin Blends
- Granny Apple Green Light Stampin Blends
- Stampin' Blends Color Lifter

Accessories

- Mossy Meadow Braided Linen Trim

Tools

- Paper Trimmer - 152392
- Dragonflies Punch

Adhesives

- Tombow Multipurpose Glue
- Stampin Dimensionals
- Mini Glue Dots

Cutting Guide ..

- Bumble Bee – 29.7cm x 10.5cm – score at 14.8cm
- Whisper White – 14.4cm x 5.4cm (2), 7cm x 1.4cm
- Dandy Garden
 - Dragonfly paper
 - Bumble Bee Dandelion paper – 10.4cm x 14.4cm



Card Construction

1. After scoring/burnishing Bumble Bee Card Base measure 2.5cm in from each side. Cut these two sides off up to score/burnish line.
2. Take your two pieces of Whisper White (same size) Stamp flowers on one in memento tuxedo black ink. Stamp your 'May good things' sentiment on other piece in Misty Moonlight.
3. Colour your flowers using Stampin' Blends. If you don't have Stampin Blends use your markers or watercolor pencils. *If you are using your Stampin' Write markers or Aqua Painters you will need to stamp your flower in Stazon Jetblack first.*
4. Affix the large patterned piece to the inside of your card. Affix your sentiment panel in the centre - directly under the Bumble Flap.
5. Affix your flowers to the centre Bumble Bee Flap on the front of the card.
6. Stamp the small sentiment on the small white strip and using snips make a flag edge. Affix on front flap to the right.
7. Punch Dragonflies from patterned paper. You will need to cut these away first before punching. Use a post-it note as a handle if needed to get your dragonfly easily lined up in the punch.
8. Affix large dragonfly with Dimensionals.
9. Affix small dragonfly with Multipurpose Glue on the top right.
10. Tie a bow with the Mossy Meadow Braided Trim and affix below flagged sentiment with a Mini Glue Dot.
11. Clean Stamps and pack away.

Try this variation ...

Dandy Garden Fun Fold Card (Landscape)



All supplies as detailed above ... although I used Watercolor Pencils to colour my flowers on this one but you can use whatever colouring method you prefer ☺

Cutting Guide ..

- Bumble Bee – 21cm x 14.8cm – score at 10.5cm
- Whisper White – 10cm x 6.5cm (2), 6.5cm x 1.9cm
- Dandy Garden
 - Dragonfly paper
 - Bumble Bee Dandelion paper – 10.4cm x 14.4cm

Card Construction

1. After scoring/burnishing Bumble Bee Card Base measure 4cm in from each side. Cut these two sides off up to score/burnish line.
2. Take your two pieces of Whisper White (same size) Stamp flowers on one in Stazon Jet black ink. Stamp your 'Inspiration' sentiment on other piece in Misty Moonlight. Clean your tall flower stamp and ink up in Misty Moonlight. Stamp off 3 times then stamp on sentiment piece below sentiment.
3. Colour your flowers using Watercolor Pencils and blend with Aqua Painters.
4. Affix the large patterned piece to the inside of your card. Affix your sentiment panel in the centre - directly under the Bumble Flap.
5. Affix your flowers to the centre Bumble Bee Flap on the front of the card.
6. Stamp the 'Thank You' sentiment on the small white strip. Affix on front flap to the left.
7. Punch Dragonflies from patterned paper. You will need to cut these away first before punching. Use a post-it note as a handle if needed to get your dragonfly easily lined up in the punch.
8. Affix large dragonfly with Dimensionals.
9. Affix small dragonfly with Multipurpose Glue on the top right.
10. Clean Stamps and pack away.
