

Scallop Tag Concertina Card



Supplies

- Cardstock 10 ¾" x 4 1/8"
- Cardstock 1 (Pink Pirouette) 5 x 2" x 3 3 ¼"
- Cardstock 2 (Vanilla) 5 x 1 7/8" x 3 1/8" plus extra for petals
- Scallop Tag Topper Punch #133324
- Simply Scored #122334
- Petite Petals Stamp Set #133152
- Petite Petals Punch #133322
- Thoughts and Prayers #127805
- Pink Pirouette Classic Ink Pad #126956
- Primrose Petals Classic Ink Pad #126858
- Baked Brown Sugar Classic Ink Pad #131174
- Scissors
- Ribbon #122981
- Linen Thread #104199
- Tombow MultiPurpose Adhesive #110755
- Mini Glue Dots #103683
- Stampin Sponges #101610
- Basic Pearl Jewels #119247

Instructions

- 1. Take your large piece of cardstock and along the long edge slide it into your punch. Buffer the edge in and push it in as far as it will go, line it up with the edge of your punch and punch. Slide your cardstock through and line it up against the next edge of the cardstock with the edge of the punch and punch. Repeat this until you have 5 scallops. Remove from Punch.
- 2. Use your trimmer to slice off the remainder of the cardstock.
- 3. Pop your piece onto your Simply Scored and score between each scallop top. You may need to move your cardstock slightly to evenly line up the score line between each scallop. Burnish your score lines with a Bone Folder
- 4. Adhere your Cardstock 1/Pink Pirouette to each panel.
- 5. Take your five Vanilla pieces and stamp your petite petals stamp randomly first in Pink Pirouette, then in Primrose Petals with a 2nd stamping (stamp off on scrap first)
- 6. Stamp greeting on first Panel in Baked Brown Sugar. Sponge edges with the sponges and Baked Brown Sugar and adhere to Pink/CS1 panels.
- 7. Stamp 5 Petals in Primrose Petals and punch out. Adhere one to each panel with a mini glue dot. Pop a pearl on each flower.
- 8. Slide your Pink Ribbon through the slots at the top and tie the Linen Thread around the ribbon in a knot or a bow.
